HOW TO INSERT A KMZ FILE INTO GOOGLE EARTH

Google Earth allows you to explore the planet in 3D through satellite imagery, maps, and other geographic information. You can add KMZ files to view additional geospatial data. Here's how to do it:

Step 1: Open Google Earth

Make sure you have Google Earth installed on your computer. Launch the app.

Step 2: Import the KMZ File

- 1. In Google Earth, go to the top menu and select "File".
- 2. Choose "Open" from the drop-down menu.
- 3. Navigate to the location where you saved your KMZ file.
- 4. Select the KMZ file: potential_sites_car_circuit.kmz to add and click "Open".

Step 3: View the Content

After adding the KMZ file, Google Earth will automatically display the geospatial data it contains. Explore information using Google Earth's navigation controls.

Step 4: Customize the display (optional)

You can customize the appearance of your KMZ file by adjusting the display properties. Right-click on the KMZ file name in the Google Earth sidebar and select "Properties". You can change the opacity, color, and other settings.

Step 5: Save (Optional)

If you want to save your current view with the added KMZ file, you can select "Save Image" from the "File" menu.
